

Credit Transfer Regulations for Students who previously studied in other Universities or Community Colleges

- The equivalence of courses studied by a student at any other university or community college is electronically determined by the departments responsible for teaching those courses, in accordance with the prevailing course equivalence instructions.
- The following conditions are required for the equivalence of courses studied by a student at another university or community college (Diploma Certificate):
 - The time elapsed since the completion of the course should not exceed seven years from the last semester of study to the date of acceptance into the university. The grade should not be less than (C) or (60%) or its equivalent in that course or courses studied at the other university.
 - The time elapsed since the completion of the course should not exceed seven years from the last semester of the student's study, not from the date of the comprehensive exam. The grade should not be less than (C+) or (68%) or its equivalent in that course or courses, except for pharmacy and engineering specialties, where the grade should not be less than (C+) or (70%) or its equivalent for a student who studied at the community college (Diploma Certificate), whether studied in Jordan or abroad.
- Practical training courses are not eligible for equivalence.
- The student is not credited for more than (50%) of these courses in his/her transferred academic plan.
- Grades equivalent to these courses are not included in the calculation of the semester and cumulative GPA at the university.
- The student is subject to external transfer regulations regarding the duration, nature, and number of approved credit hours required for graduation. The student must successfully complete at the University of Jordan no less than half of the required credit hours for graduation according to the approved study plan at the time of admission. This should include at least half of the credit hours approved for mandatory and elective specialization requirements.

- One semester is deducted from the maximum graduation years for every 15 credit hours transferred.
